What Am I Made For?

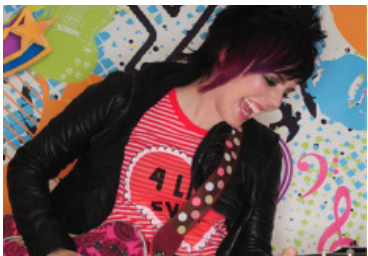
For from him and through him and to him are all things. To Him be the glory forever. Amen.

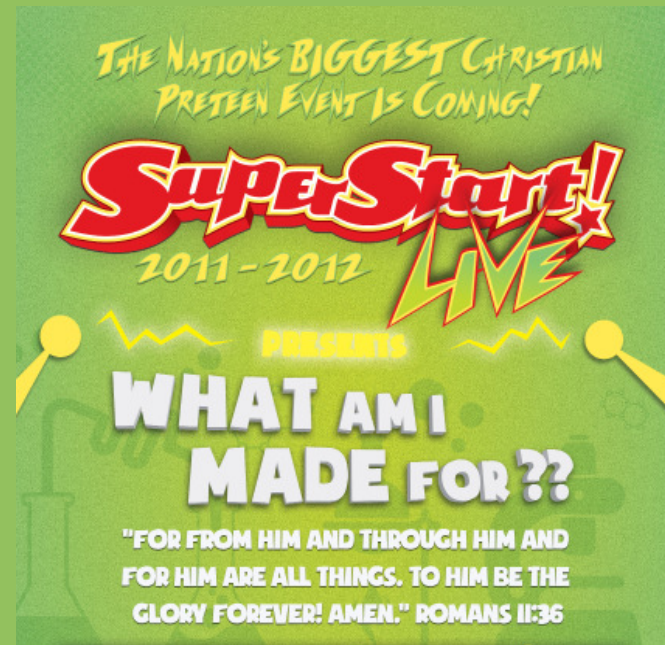


"YANCY" will be the featured artist this year at SuperStart! Her message is very relevant to 4th, 5th & 6th graders.
